

Tenure-track position at the Institute of Microbiology in Třeboň

The Institute of Microbiology in Trebon, Czech Rep., is looking for a highly motivated scientist for a **5-year tenure track position in the Laboratory of Anoxygenic Phototrophs**. The applicant should hold a PhD degree in microbiology, biochemistry, molecular biology or similar fields and have at least three years of postdoctoral experience. The candidate should have experience with genomics or transcriptomics of anoxygenic phototrophic bacteria. The candidate should have at least 15 publications over the last 5 years, and a Hirsch index >10.
